

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR CERTIFIABLY SINGLE AFRICA

Certiably Single Africa (the “Company”) is committed to the responsible handling of customer information. This Privacy Policy discloses the privacy practices for the Company and the Services provided by the Company, as such term is defined in the Terms of Use.

The company gathers certain types of information about online users and wants to help you understand the policies regarding the collection and use of that information. Our Online Privacy Policy applies generally to the website and the content located therein and any other related websites. By accepting the Privacy Policy and the Terms of Use, you expressly consent to our collection, storage, use, and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy below.

WHAT INFORMATION DOES THE COMPANY COLLECT ABOUT YOU ON THIS WEBSITE AND WHAT DOES IT DO WITH THE INFORMATION?

You can browse our site without telling us who you are or revealing any personal information about yourself. Once you give us your personal information, you are not anonymous to us. If you choose to provide us with personal information, you consent to the transfer and storage of that information in our servers. Our primary goal in collecting information from you is to provide you with a smooth, efficient, and customized experience while using the website.

The personally-identifiable information (“personal information” or “your information”) collected on this website can include some or all of the following – your name, address, phone number, email address, birthday, and sometimes financial information such as credit/debit card numbers.

We also retain any personal information you provide if you contact us directly through the website. If you do not wish this to occur then do not provide personal information to the website that you expect to keep private.

Finally, your internet browser has a feature called “cookies”, which stores small amounts of data on your computer about your visit to our site. Cookies tell us nothing about who you are, however, unless you specifically give us personal information. You do not need to have cookies turned on to visit our site. You

can disable cookies within your browser or you can delete the cookies from your browser. It is possible, however, that some portions of this website may not function properly if the cookies are disabled.

HOW WILL THE COMPANY USE MY PERSONAL INFORMATION?

The Company receives your personal information in order to provide you with a safe and efficient experience. You agree that we may use your personal information to:

- Provide the services and customer support you request;
- Resolve disputes, collect fees, and troubleshoot problems;
- Send you notices, updates, and support messages;
- Respond to your comments and requests;
- Prevent potentially prohibited or illegal activities, and enforce our Terms of Use;
- Customize, measure and improve our services, content and advertising;
- Compare information for accuracy, and verify it with third parties; and
- Carry out any other purpose as described to you at the time the information is being collected.

WITH WHOM DOES THE COMPANY SHARE THE INFORMATION?

We may disclose personal information to respond to legal requirements, enforce our policies, and respond to claims that content violates the rights of others, or protect anyone's rights, property, or safety. Such information will be disclosed in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Pursuant to this Section, we may share your personal information with law enforcement or other governmental officials, in response to a verified request relating to a criminal investigation or alleged illegal activity. In such events, we will disclose information relevant to the investigation. The Company also reserves the right to share your personal information with other business entities, should we plan to merge with or be acquired by that business entity.

Without limiting the above, in an effort to respect your privacy and our ability to keep the community free from bad actors, we will not otherwise disclose your personal information to law enforcement, other government officials, or other third parties without a subpoena, court order or substantially similar legal procedure, except when we believe in good faith that the disclosure of information is necessary to prevent harm to the general public, users of the website, or to protect the rights, property, or public safety of the general public or users due to any suspected illegal activity.

While we will never sell or rent your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes without your explicit consent, we may combine your information with information we collect from other companies and use it to improve and personalize our services, content, and advertising. We do not share your photos, contact information or background information under any circumstances. We

provide complete privacy to our customers in respect to your dating profile. Your information will not be disclosed by the Company except as discussed in this Privacy Policy.

HOW DO I CORRECT OR UPDATE MY PERSONAL INFORMATION?

We believe you should have the ability to access and edit your personal information. Generally, we will not manually modify your personal information.
